**(From: Scripture Union East & West Asia: February 2012)**

**\* Special programs which will be held at the beginning of February.**

- **INDONESIA** = Pray for pastors' training of SU Bible Reading Method in Bali of 1-4 Feb. Hans Wuysang and Rimawaty Pantou and Christian Jonch (SU Indonesia partner) will be the facilitators for the workshops. Please pray for a draft of MOU to be discussed by GKPB (Christian Protestant Church of Bali) and SU Indonesia.
- **HONG KONG and MACAU** = 2-3 Feb. There is a Bible camp, studying "Song of Songs". Please pray for the speaker Dr. Ho Kit and all the participants.

**\* 1 (Wed.) = MALAYSIA, SABAH:**

- Pray earnestly for the "Pray & Plan retreat" of the new PGKS (Sabah Christian Teachers Fellowship Committee), 3 & 4 Feb. Pray that God will give us deep insight, faith, courage to do what He wants us to do.

**\* 2 (Thu.) = PENINSULAR MALAYSIA :**

1. 4-6 Feb. = "Inter-Generation Camp" with Faith Evangelical Church. Jennifer Chew, Lue Jun Yi and Christopher Cheah are facilitating this camp. Christopher will be taking 3 sessions based on Luke 5:1-11. Jennifer and Jun Yi are taking workshops for the children and youths. This is one of the programs we offer to churches to partner with us.
